Team Gifts

- Evangelism: passionately leading others to the saving knowledge of Christ (Eph 4:11)
- Prophecy: boldly and fearlessly proclaiming God's truth (Rom 12:6; Eph 4:11; 1 Cor 12:10, 28)
- Teaching: making clear the truth of God's Word with simplicity and accuracy (Rom 12:7; 1 Cor 12:28)
- Exhortation: motivating others to action, application, and purpose (Rom 12:8)
- Shepherding: overseeing, training, feeding, coaching/leading (Eph 4:11)
- Serving: providing practical help both physically and spiritually (Rom 12:7; 1 Cor 12:28)
- Mercy-showing: identifying with and comforting those in need (Rom 12:8)
- Giving: releasing material resources to further the work of the Church (Rom 12:8)
- Administration: organizing, administering, promoting, leading (Rom 12:8; 1 Cor 12:28)
